



West Jamaica Conference Mentorship Program

CRITERIA FOR MENTORS

Kindly see below the basic requirements for mentors:

- Be a baptized member of a Seventh-day Adventist Church in West Jamaica Conference in good and regular standing.
- Ideally reside in the same geographical locale as individuals to be mentored.
- Be willing to adhere to the policies and procedures of the Mentorship Programme of West Jamaica Conference.
- Agree to a one-year commitment to the Programme.
- Commit to spending a minimum of eight (8) hours a month with the mentee(s)
- Be willing to communicate with the mentee(s) on a weekly basis.
- Complete the screening procedure.
- Agree to attend mentorship training as required.
- Be willing to provide regular updates regarding the mentor-mentee(s) engagement.
- Have a clean criminal history. If the applicant has been convicted of a felony, then they may be considered only after a period of two (2) years, with demonstrated good behaviours and an appropriate and corrective attitude regarding past behaviours.
- Have never been arrested, charged, or convicted of child abuse or molestation.
- Not be a user of illicit drugs.
- Not use alcohol or harmful substances.
- Not currently be in treatment for substance abuse. If a substance abuse problem has occurred in the past, the applicant must have completed a non-addictive period of at least two (2) years.
- Not currently be under treatment for a mental disorder or have been hospitalized for a mental disorder in the past three (3) years.
- Should not have falsified information during the screening process.
